Percussion Players OPTIONAL:

Percussion students may be interested in purchasing a percussion kit. Majestic (brand) have put together kits that include reasonable quality glockenspiels with the option to include a snare drum in a

handy travel case. These kits can be used through to yr 12. It is NOT COMPULORY but a great option for a percussion student's wishing to continue in the program.
