Under this agreement for 2017 Dysart State High School will receive

This funding will be used to


- Increase the percentage of students achieving in the U2B in Writing from 10% in Year 5 to 20% in Year 7.
- Increase the percentage of students achieving in the U2B in Writing from 11.5% in Year 7 to 20% in Year 9.
- Increase the percentage of students receiving C or greater in English, Mathematics and Science across Year 7 to Year 10 to 85%.
- Increase overall school attendance from 89% to 92%.
- Decrease the percentage of students attending < 85% from 28.3% to 15%.
- Improve school performance and build leadership capacity.

Our initiatives include

- Participation of U2B Year 7, 8 & 9 students in the Impact Centre – Just Write Program.
- Training teacher aides to deliver the Reading Link and Accelerated Reader programs.
- Use of the Mathletics program to engage students in Mathematics and provide differentiation.
- Providing professional development and coaching to build teacher knowledge of the Australian Curriculum and build their capacity to plan, teach and assess using C2C resources.
- Employment of a teacher aide to track attendance according to our Attendance Strategy.
- Engagement of Educational Consultant, Glenn McGowan, each term to build leadership capacity and enhance school performance.

Building Leadership Capacity and enhancing school performance utilising education consultant	\$5000
